-Patient Eligibility Requirements-
For Paradise Park Clinic

- New patients must go through an eligibility screening process and be approved for services before a medical appointment is made.
- If a patient is determined to be eligible, all members of that patient's immediate family (spouse, domestic partner, and children) are also eligible to receive treatment unless that family member has coverage under a public or private health insurance program, or the services would be eligible for payment by workman's compensation.
- Patients are eligible only if the patient, or a member of their immediate family, has been employed, received unemployment benefits, received disability payments (but was not eligible for Medicare or Medicaid coverage) or received Worker's Compensation benefits (as long as the treatment being received would not be covered by Workers Compensation) during the 6 months preceding the rendering of medical services.
- Patients will be re-screened for eligibility every 3 months following date of initial approval.
- Must be a resident of Clark County for a minimum of 3 months in order to qualify for services. Proof of residence will be required (i.e. utility bill, lease agreement, school registration, photo ID).
- Must provide proof of employment or employment status (i.e. pay stubs, proof of unemployment wages, W-2 report, proof of weekly strike payment)
- Must provide photo identification (i.e. driver's license or state-issued I.D.)
- Household income must not be more than 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) guidelines, updated annually (currently \$44,100 for a family of 4).
- All family members in the household who earn wages or receive unemployment benefits must provide income verification for the past 3

months to ensure that the household income does not exceed 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.

- Must not qualify for any federal or state medical assistance program (Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP).
- Must not currently be enrolled in any public or private health insurance plan or program.
- VMSN does not cover individuals whose injuries are covered under Worker's Compensation.
- VMSN will not provide services to patients who will seek payment for the injury treated by VMSN by a lawsuit or other legal action.
- VMSN will not discriminate against patients on the basis of race, sex, color, age, national origin, sexual orientation or disability.
